




Cumulative confirmed COVID-19 cases per 1000 (as of Dec 13, 2022)




Cumulative confirmed COVID-19 deaths per million people (as of Dec 13, 2022)




Hospital beds per 1000 (2021 or latest available)




Intensive care units (ICU) beds per 100,000 (2020 or latest available)

Japan's Medical System: Repeatedly Collapsing as COVID-19 Cases Surge




